Workshop One, 27 May 2013

Cognitive assessment tool for the assessment of the person with dementia

Using the Hierarchic Dementia Scale (HDS) to enhance well-being for people living with dementia

Registrations for this workshop are restricted to **tertiary qualified health professionals** including Registered Nurses working in acute, residential or community settings, particularly those caring for people living with dementia.

The HDS is a reliable and valid assessment tool that accurately measures cognitive function not only in terms of impaired function but more importantly in terms of remaining abilities. The HDS addresses a wide range of severity and is sensitive enough to detect change over time. It is safe and inexpensive to use.

At the conclusion of the workshop participants will be able to:

- Explain the administration and scoring of the Hierarchic Dementia Scale (HDS)
- Interpret the results of the HDS to determine abilities and limitations of the person in terms of self-care, communication and interaction
- Use the results of the HDS to plan and implement appropriate strategies to encourage abilities and support limitations of the person with dementia

<u>Workshop Two, 28 May 2013</u> Supporting Strategies for health professionals caring for people with dementia: A possibility oriented approach

Registrations for this workshop are open to both **tertiary and non-tertiary qualified health professionals** caring for people living with dementia.

At the conclusion of the workshop participants will be able to apply principles of a possibilities approach to enhance communication, participation, the environment and health and well-being by supporting abilities and limitations of the person with dementia.
